Mahaffey Camp Young Adult Retreat

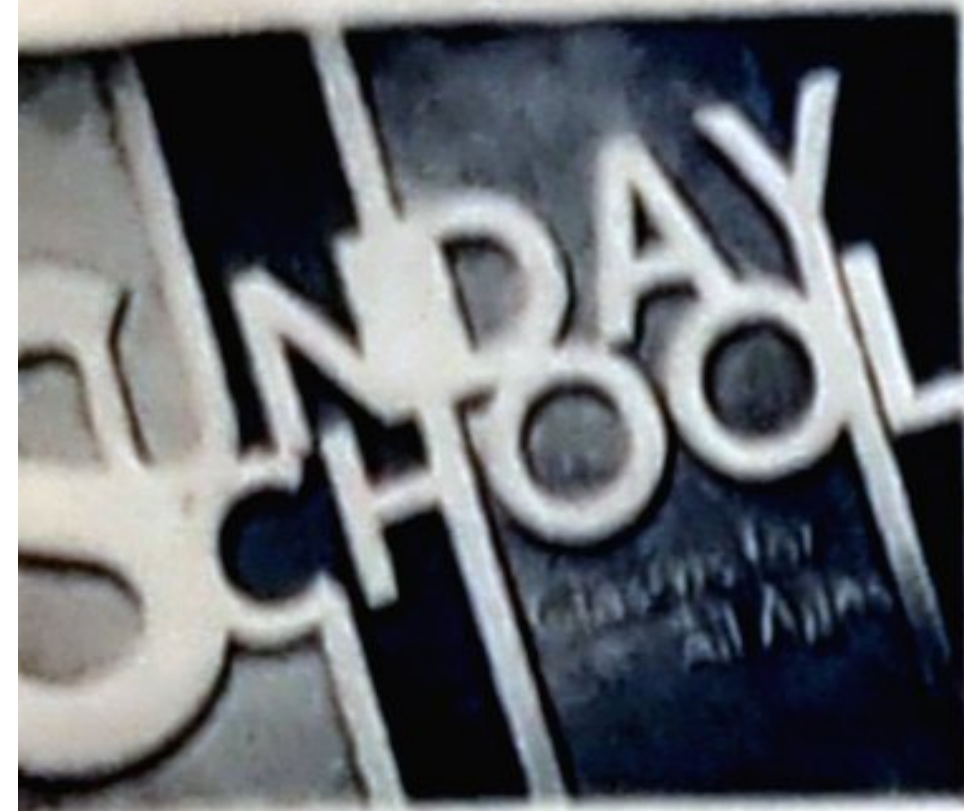
Looking for a way to connect with other young adults as you walk through life?

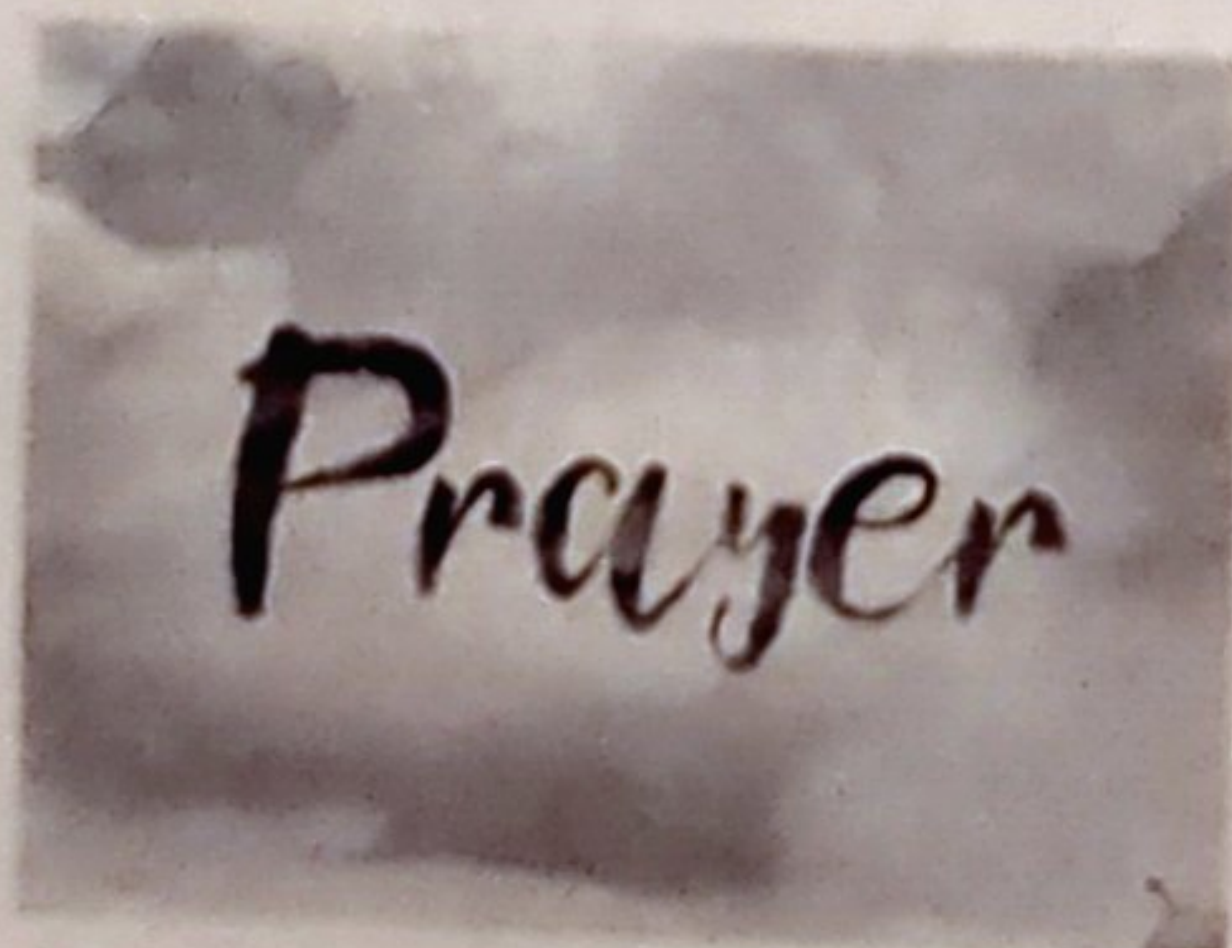
