Proclaiming God's Truth Through the Radio

BURKINA FASO—You drove forward the work of **four radio stations** in Burkina Faso that, despite fierce opposition to Christianity in the region, continued to boldly proclaim the gospel, hold call-in times of prayer, and offer other Christ-centered programming. Each week, Alliance international workers in Burkina Faso hear of **people coming to Christ through radio ministry**. Last year, three women, dressed in traditional attire of the region's majority religion, even showed up at one of the stations to express their gratitude to the director. As they revealed during their visit, they had been meeting secretly to listen to the radio and discuss what they had heard. **Each had come to faith in Jesus through these secret listening sessions!**
